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## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Resources and Education for All Prisons (REAP) Act**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services  
4 to assist inmates in accessing certain federal education grants; requiring the  
5 Maryland Department of Labor to set certain goals relating to inmates in education  
6 programs and establish certain tracking systems relating to inmates in education  
7 programs; requiring the ~~State Department of Education~~ Maryland Higher Education  
8 Commission and the Department of Human Services to assist the Maryland  
9 Department of Labor in establishing certain tracking systems; and generally relating  
10 to resources and education for inmates.

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
2 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 **Article – Correctional Services**

4 **SUBTITLE 7. INMATE ACCESS TO FEDERAL PELL GRANTS.**

5 **2–701.**

6 (A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ASSIST INMATES IN ACCESSING FEDERAL  
7 PELL GRANTS FOR HIGHER EDUCATION.

8 (B) IN ORDER TO ASSIST INMATES IN ACCESSING FEDERAL PELL GRANTS,  
9 THE DEPARTMENT SHALL CONSULT WITH INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION,  
10 INCLUDING:

- 11 (1) THE UNIVERSITY OF BALTIMORE;
- 12 (2) MORGAN STATE UNIVERSITY;
- 13 (3) BOWIE STATE UNIVERSITY;
- 14 (4) THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND GLOBAL CAMPUS;
- 15 (5) ANNE ARUNDEL COMMUNITY COLLEGE;
- 16 (6) HAGERSTOWN COMMUNITY COLLEGE;
- 17 (7) WOR–WIC COMMUNITY COLLEGE; AND
- 18 (8) GOUCHER COLLEGE.

20 THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS

24 (A) IN THIS SECTION, “INMATE” HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 1–101 OF  
25 THE CORRECTIONAL SERVICES ARTICLE.

26 (B) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL:

1 (1) SET GOALS FOR THE NUMBER OF INMATES IN EDUCATION  
2 PROGRAMS;

3 (2) ESTABLISH A TRACKING SYSTEM FOR THE NUMBER OF INMATES  
4 IN EDUCATION PROGRAMS; AND

5 (3) ESTABLISH A TRACKING SYSTEM FOR THE PROGRESS OF INMATES  
6 IN EDUCATION PROGRAMS, INCLUDING THE NUMBER OF COLLEGE CREDITS THAT  
7 EACH INMATE EARNS IN AN APPROVED COLLEGE PROGRAM.

8 (C) ~~THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION~~ MARYLAND HIGHER  
9 EDUCATION COMMISSION AND THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES SHALL  
10 ASSIST THE DEPARTMENT IN CREATING THE TRACKING SYSTEMS UNDER  
11 SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.

12 (D) THE GOVERNOR SHALL PROVIDE FUNDING ANNUALLY IN THE BUDGET  
13 BILL FOR THE DEPARTMENT TO USE FOR ~~EDUCATION PROGRAMS, INCLUDING~~  
14 ~~MARKETING FOR EDUCATION PROGRAMS TO INMATES AND~~ FOR THE TRACKING  
15 SYSTEMS FOR EDUCATION PROGRAMS.

16 (E) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS  
17 SECTION.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
19 ~~October~~ July 1, 2023.
