Worcester County - Natural Resources - Hunting

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Department of Natural Resources to allow a person in 4 Worcester County to hunt game birds or game mammals on a Sunday, subject to 5 certain time restrictions, during the open season for that game bird or game 6 mammal; authorizing the Department to allow a person in Worcester County to hunt 7 on public land designated for hunting on Sundays, subject to certain time restrictions; altering the safety zone in Worcester County within which archery 8 9 hunting may not take place except under certain circumstances; and generally 10 relating to hunting in Worcester County.



SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect Jul. 1, 2023.
(6) In Montgomery County or Washington County, an archery hunter shat be in an elevated position that allows the hunter to shoot in a downward trajectory when hunting any wild bird or mammal within 50 to 100 yards of a dwelling house, residence church, public or nonpublic school, or other building or camp occupied by human beings.
(5) In Harford County, an archery hunter shall use a tree stand who hunting any wild bird or mammal within 50 to 100 yards of a dwelling house, residence church, public or nonpublic school, or other building or camp occupied by human beings.
