BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 9 That: 10 There is a Waterway Incident Notification System (WINS) Workgroup. (a) 11 The Workgroup consists of the following members: (b) 12 (1) one member of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President of the Senate: 13 14 (2)one member of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of the House: 15 16 the Secretary of Emergency Management, or the Secretary's designee; (3)17 the Chair of the Maryland 9–1–1 Board, or the Chair's designee; **(4)** 18 (5)the Superintendent of the Natural Resources Police, or the Superintendent's designee: 19 20 the Secretary of Information Technology, or the Secretary's designee; (6) 21 and



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- 1 (7)the following representatives: 2 one representative from the Dorchester County Emergency 3 Management Division, appointed by the Director of the Dorchester County Department of Emergency Services; 4 5 one representative from the Anne Arundel County Office of (ii) 6 Emergency Management, appointed by the Director of the Anne Arundel County Office of 7 Emergency Management; and 8 one representative from the St. Mary's County Emergency Management Division, appointed by the Director of the St. Mary's County Department of 9 Emergency Services. 10 The Secretary of Emergency Management, or the Secretary's designee, shall 11 (c) 12 designate the chair of the Workgroup. 13 (d) The Maryland Department of Emergency Management shall provide staff for 14 the Workgroup. A member of the Workgroup: 15 (e) may not receive compensation as a member of the Workgroup; but 16 (1) 17 is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State (2)18 Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget. 19 (f) The Workgroup shall study and make recommendations regarding: 20 (1) the feasibility of establishing a Waterway Incident Notification System 21to notify members of the public, including recreational boaters and commercial watermen, 22of active waterway emergencies involving a person at risk of death or serious bodily harm, 23emergency marine events, or marine hazards; and 24 potential partnerships between the State, the U.S. Coast Guard, the 25U.S. Navy, and nearby states to improve notifications to members of the public, including recreational boaters and commercial watermen, of waterway emergencies involving a 26 27 person at risk of death or serious bodily harm, emergency marine events, or marine hazards. 28 29 On or before December 31, 2023, the Workgroup shall report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2-1257 of the State 30
- 32 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2023. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and 1 month and, at the end of June
