- 15 19–4A–10.
- 16 **(A)** Except as provided by federal law, licensure under this subtitle does not entitle a residential service agency to reimbursement by a third party payor.
- 18 (B) THE DEPARTMENT MAY REIMBURSE A RESIDENTIAL SERVICE AGENCY
- 19 FOR PERSONAL ASSISTANCE SERVICES ONLY IF THE PERSONAL ASSISTANCE
- 20 SERVICES ARE PROVIDED BY AN INDIVIDUAL CLASSIFIED AS AN EMPLOYEE.
- 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
