- FOR the purpose of authorizing the Public Service Commission to enforce certain prevailing 4 wage requirements for contractors and subcontractors working on certain projects involving, and traffic control activities related to, underground gas or electric infrastructure of an investor—owned gas company, electric company, or combination gas and electric company; and generally relating to investor-owned utilities and the 8 enforcement of prevailing wage laws.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 18 This section applies to a project by an investor-owned gas company, electric 19 company, or combination gas and electric company involving the construction, 20reconstruction, installation, demolition, restoration, or alteration of any underground gas 21 or electric infrastructure of the company, and any related traffic control activities.
