- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 19 Article Alcoholic Beverages
- 20 16–102.
- 21 This title applies only in Carroll County.
- 22 16–1312.
- 23 (a) The Board may issue a Class C multiple event beer, wine, and liquor license.

- The license authorizes the license holder to exercise any privilege conferred 1 (b) 2 by a Class C beer, wine, and liquor license at an entertainment event held by a county fire 3 department or an arts center on West Main Street in Westminster.
- 4 (c) (1) The license shall be in the form that the Board requires.
- The applicant shall sign the license. 5 (2)
- 6 The total number of days for which a multiple event license may be used (d) (1)may not exceed 40 in a calendar year. 7
- 8 **(2)** A fire department or an arts center on West Main Street in Westminster 9 may not be issued a multiple event license more than one time in a calendar year.
- The annual fee for the license is: 10 (e)
- 11 (1) \$125, for not more than 10 events per year;
- 12 (2)\$250, for not more than 20 events per year;
- 13 \$375, for not more than 30 events per year; [and] (3)
- 14 \$500, for not more than 40 events per year; AND **(4)**
- 15 **(5)** \$2,000 FOR 41 OR MORE EVENTS PER YEAR.
- 16 A fire company or an arts center on West Main Street in Westminster that 17 holds a Class C multiple event license is not precluded from obtaining a Class C per diem 18 license under this subtitle.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 19 1, 2023. 20
