## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Carroll County – Alcoholic Beverages – Multiple Event Entertainment Licenses**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the fee for a certain multiple event entertainment alcoholic  
4 beverages license in Carroll County; repealing the limit on the total number of days  
5 for which a multiple event entertainment license may be used; and generally relating  
6 to alcoholic beverages licenses in Carroll County.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

20 16–102.

21 This title applies only in Carroll County.

22 16–1312.

23 (a) The Board may issue a Class C multiple event beer, wine, and liquor license.

1 (b) The license authorizes the license holder to exercise any privilege conferred  
2 by a Class C beer, wine, and liquor license at an entertainment event held by a county fire  
3 department or an arts center on West Main Street in Westminster.

4 (c) (1) The license shall be in the form that the Board requires.

5 (2) The applicant shall sign the license.

6 (d) [(1) The total number of days for which a multiple event license may be used  
7 may not exceed 40 in a calendar year.

8 (2)] A fire department or an arts center on West Main Street in Westminster  
9 may not be issued a multiple event license more than one time in a calendar year.

10 (e) The annual fee for the license is:

11 (1) \$125, for not more than 10 events per year;

12 (2) \$250, for not more than 20 events per year;

13 (3) \$375, for not more than 30 events per year; [and]

14 (4) \$500, for not more than 40 events per year; AND

15 (5) **\$2,000 FOR 41 OR MORE EVENTS PER YEAR.**

16 (f) A fire company or an arts center on West Main Street in Westminster that  
17 holds a Class C multiple event license is not precluded from obtaining a Class C per diem  
18 license under this subtitle.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
20 1, 2023.
