A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Human Services – Temporary Cash Assistance – Housing Allowance

FOR the purpose of requiring a local department of social services to provide a housing
 allowance to certain households receiving temporary cash assistance; requiring the
 continuation of a housing allowance for a certain time period under certain
 circumstances; and generally relating to temporary cash assistance.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 Article Human Services
- 15 **5–314.1.**
- 16 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "ELIGIBLE HOUSEHOLD" MEANS A HOUSEHOLD THAT:
- 17(1) RECEIVES TEMPORARY CASH ASSISTANCE OR TRANSITIONAL18SUPPORT SERVICES; AND

19(2) IS NOT RECEIVING A FEDERAL, STATE, OR LOCAL HOUSING20SUBSIDY WHERE THE TENANT'S PORTION OF RENT IS BASED ON A PERCENTAGE OF21THE TENANT'S INCOME.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW. [Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 (B) A LOCAL DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE AN ELIGIBLE HOUSEHOLD WITH 2 A HOUSING ALLOWANCE OF AT LEAST:

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(1) \$350 PER MONTH FOR A HOUSEHOLD OF ONE; AND

4 (2) AN ADDITIONAL \$100 PER MONTH FOR EACH ADDITIONAL 5 HOUSEHOLD MEMBER.

6 (C) A HOUSEHOLD SHALL BE ELIGIBLE FOR A HOUSING ALLOWANCE FOR A 7 FULL MONTH IF THE HOUSEHOLD IS ELIGIBLE FOR ANY PORTION OF THAT MONTH.

8 (D) (1) A LOCAL DEPARTMENT SHALL PAY THE HOUSING ALLOWANCE 9 DIRECTLY TO THE HOUSEHOLD THROUGH THE SAME METHOD OF PAYMENT AS THE 10 TEMPORARY CASH ASSISTANCE RECEIVED BY THE HOUSEHOLD.

11 (2) A HOUSING ALLOWANCE SHALL BE ISSUED AS A SEPARATE 12 PAYMENT IN ADDITION TO THE TEMPORARY CASH ASSISTANCE PAYMENT.

(E) IF A HOUSEHOLD THAT WAS PREVIOUSLY INELIGIBLE FOR A HOUSING
 ALLOWANCE REPORTS A CHANGE IN CIRCUMSTANCES THAT WOULD QUALIFY THE
 HOUSEHOLD FOR A HOUSING ALLOWANCE, A LOCAL DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE THE
 HOUSING ALLOWANCE WITHIN 10 DAYS OF THE REPORTED CHANGE.

17 (F) (1) ON OR BEFORE NOVEMBER 1, 2023, EACH LOCAL DEPARTMENT 18 SHALL SCREEN FOR HOUSING ALLOWANCE ELIGIBILITY ALL:

19(I)CURRENT RECIPIENTS OF TEMPORARY CASH ASSISTANCE20OR TRANSITIONAL SUPPORT SERVICES; AND

21(II) INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE RECEIVED TEMPORARY CASH22ASSISTANCE IN THE IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING 3 MONTHS.

23 (2) A LOCAL DEPARTMENT SHALL SCREEN FOR HOUSING 24 ALLOWANCE ELIGIBILITY ALL:

25 (I) APPLICANTS FOR TEMPORARY CASH ASSISTANCE; AND

26 (II) RECIPIENTS OF TEMPORARY CASH ASSISTANCE AT 27 REDETERMINATION.

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1 (G) A HOUSING ALLOWANCE RECEIVED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE 2 DISREGARDED IN DETERMINING THE AMOUNT OF TEMPORARY CASH ASSISTANCE TO 3 BE RECEIVED BY A HOUSEHOLD.

4 (H) THE SECRETARY MAY NOT REDUCE OR TERMINATE A HOUSING 5 ALLOWANCE FOR A HOUSEHOLD'S NONCOMPLIANCE WITH A FIP REQUIREMENT.

6 (I) FOLLOWING THE TERMINATION OF TEMPORARY CASH ASSISTANCE, A 7 HOUSING ALLOWANCE SHALL CONTINUE FOR AN ADDITIONAL 6 MONTHS IF THE 8 HOUSEHOLD IS RECEIVING OR IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION 9 ASSISTANCE PROGRAM BENEFITS.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 11 October 1, 2023.
