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- FOR the purpose of prohibiting the dispensing of prescription opioids unless the dispenser provides a personal use pharmaceutical disposal system to the ultimate user at no cost; authorizing the Maryland Department of Health to provide personal use pharmaceutical disposal systems to certain pharmacies; and generally relating to dispensing prescription opioid drug deactivation systems.

- 19 (A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
- 20 INDICATED.
- 21 (B) "PERSONAL USE PHARMACEUTICAL DISPOSAL SYSTEM" MEANS A
- 22 PORTABLE PRODUCT DESIGNED FOR USE BY AN ULTIMATE USER FOR THE PURPOSE



- 1 OF ALLOWING THE ULTIMATE USER TO DEACTIVATE THE PRESCRIBED OPIOID TO A
- 2 NONRETRIEVABLE CONDITION OR STATE.
- 3 (C) "Ultimate user" means an individual who has lawfully
- 4 OBTAINED AND POSSESSES A PRESCRIBED OPIOID FOR PERSONAL USE OR FOR THE
- 5 USE BY A MEMBER OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S HOUSEHOLD.

- 7 AN OPIOID PRESCRIPTION MAY NOT BE DISPENSED IN THE STATE UNLESS THE
- 8 DISPENSER PROVIDES A PERSONAL USE PHARMACEUTICAL DISPOSAL SYSTEM TO

- 17 (C) THE DEPARTMENT MAY PROCURE PERSONAL USE PHARMACEUTICAL
- 18 **DISPOSAL SYSTEMS:**
- 19 (1) THROUGH DONATION BY A MANUFACTURER OF PERSONAL USE
- 20 PHARMACEUTICAL SYSTEMS; AND
- 21 (2) WITH FUNDING FROM THE OPIOID RESTITUTION FUND
- 22 ESTABLISHED UNDER § 7-331 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT

- 24 (D) THE DEPARTMENT MAY DEVELOP PROCEDURES TO CARRY OUT THIS
- 25 SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
