A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Maryland State Department of Education – Employee Status and Designation

FOR the purpose of requiring the Secretary of Budget and Management to assign certain
employees of the State Department of Education to the executive, management,
professional, or skilled services of the State Personnel Management System and to
assign or reassign certain employees to certain bargaining units; requiring that
certain employees of the Department suffer no diminution of pay or benefits; and
generally relating to employees of the State Department of Education.

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 10 That:

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(a) On or before January 1, 2024, the Secretary of Budget and Management shall:

12 (1) assign each employee in the State Department of Education to the 13 executive service, management service, professional service, or skilled service in the State 14 Personnel Management System, except for employees that are bona fide special 15 appointments under § 6–405(a)(3) of the State Personnel and Pensions Article; and

16 (2) if an employee is placed in the professional service and skilled service 17 in accordance with item (1) of this subsection:

(i) if the employee was not assigned to a bargaining unit at the timeof placement, assign the employee to the appropriate bargaining unit; or

20 (ii) if the employee is assigned to an inappropriate bargaining unit 21 as a result of the placement, reassign the employee to the appropriate bargaining unit.

22 (b) An employee of the State Department of Education assigned to a service in 23 the State Personnel Management System in accordance with subsection (a)(1) of this 24 section:

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1 (1) shall suffer no diminution of pay or benefits resulting from the 2 assignment; and

3 (2) in the course of the assignment, may be placed on a new salary schedule 4 only at a grade and step that results in a greater annual rate of pay.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 6 1, 2023.
