3 4 5 6	FOR the purpose of establishing the Commission to Establish a Memorial to the Global War on Terror to study establishing a memorial dedicated to Marylanders who have fought in the Global War on Terror and their families; and generally relating to the Commission to Establish a Memorial to the Global War on Terror.
7 8	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:
9	(a) There is a Commission to Establish a Memorial to the Global War on Terror.
10	(b) The Commission consists of the following members:
11	(1) the Secretary of Veterans Affairs, or the Secretary's designee;
12	(2) the Secretary of General Services, or the Secretary's designee;
13 14	(3) two representatives of the Maryland Veterans Commission, designated by the Secretary of Veterans Affairs;

- 15 four representatives of veteran services organizations, designated by the Secretary of Veterans Affairs; and 16
- 17 one representative of the Maryland National Guard, designated by the Adjutant General of Maryland.

- 1 (c) The members of the Commission shall elect a chair from among the 2 Commission's members.
- 3 (d) The Department of Veterans Affairs shall provide staff for the Commission.
- 4 (e) A member of the Commission:
- 5 (1) may not receive compensation; but
- 6 (2) is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State 7 Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.
- 8 (f) The Commission shall provide recommendations for the funding, design, 9 construction, and placement of an appropriate memorial dedicated to Marylanders who 10 fought in the Global War on Terror and their families.
- 11 (g) On or before 7 months after the effective date of this Act, the Commission shall submit a preliminary report on its findings and recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly.
- 14 (h) On or before 1 year and 3 months after the effective date of this Act, the Commission shall submit a final report on its findings and recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect on the taking effect of the termination provision specified in Section 2 of Chapter 423 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2022. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
