CHAPTER

1 AN ACT concerning

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Natural Resources - Licensed Tree Experts - Alterations

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from physically engaging in the work of the treatment, care, or removal of certain trees for compensation under a tree expert's 4 5 license unless the person is employed by the licensed tree expert, employs a licensed 6 tree expert who can provide oversight, is employed by a company that employs a 7 licensed tree expert who can provide oversight, or is a licensed tree expert; increasing a certain penalty for operating a tree expert business without a license; repealing 8 9 certain electronic reporting requirements for licensed tree experts; requiring a 10 licensed tree expert to carry, show proof of, and maintain for a certain period of time 11 valid workers' compensation insurance; altering the requirements and procedures 12 for a licensed tree expert to possess and show proof of certain insurance; and 13 generally relating to licensed tree experts.

8 9 10 11 12	(c) (1) "Tree expert" means a person who represents to the public that the person is skilled in the science of tree care or removal and who, whether in the business of the person or as the employee of another person and whether under the title of arborist, tree specialist, tree surgeon, tree expert, or otherwise, engages in the business or work of the treatment, care, or removal of trees for compensation by:
13 14	(i) Making diagnoses, prescribing, and supervising the treatment for trees; or
15 16	(ii) Trimming, pruning, thinning, cabling, shaping, removing, or reducing the crown of trees.

29	1. FOR A FIRST OFFENSE, A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$500;

7 8	[(2)] (B) An employee under the supervision of a licensed tree expert may not be required to have a license in the name of the employee.
9 10	[(b) A licensed tree expert shall within a time period established by the Department notify the Department electronically of:
11 12 13	(1) Any company that engages in the business or work of the treatment, care, or removal of trees for compensation under the tree expert's license, and any changes to that status; and
14 15 16	(2) The liability and property damage insurance and workers' compensation insurance carried by any company that engages or works under the tree expert's license, and any changes to the insurance.]
17 18 19	(c) A PERSON MAY NOT <u>PHYSICALLY</u> ENGAGE IN THE WORK OF THE TREATMENT, CARE, OR REMOVAL OF TREES FOR COMPENSATION UNDER A TREE EXPERT'S LICENSE UNLESS THE PERSON $\stackrel{\text{LS}}{\text{ES}}$:
20	(1) IS EMPLOYED BY THE LICENSED TREE EXPERT;

27 28 29	(a) The Department may examine an applicant for license as a tree expert and pass upon the competence of the applicant. It shall issue a "tree expert" license to any applicant, who:
30	(1) Pays the fee provided in § 5–419 of this subtitle;

Has attained 18 years of age;

1 2 3 4	(3) (i) Has had 2 years of approved college education in forestry, arboriculture, horticulture, applied agricultural sciences, or the equivalent education and a minimum of 1 year of experience with a licensed tree expert in Maryland or with an acceptable tree expert company in another state; or
5 6 7	(ii) For at least 3 years immediately preceding the date of application has been engaged continuously in practice as a tree expert with a licensed tree expert in Maryland or with an acceptable tree expert company in another state; and
8	(4) Has passed the examination given by the Department.
9	(b) (1) Every licensee shall [carry and show]:
10 11 12 13	(I) POSSESS proof of VALID liability and property damage insurance, AND WORKERS' COMPENSATION INSURANCE IF REQUIRED BY LAW, in the form and amount required by the Department, AT ANY TIME THE LICENSEE IS ENGAGED IN THE WORK OR BUSINESS OF A TREE EXPERT; AND
14 15	(II) SHOW PROOF OF THE REQUIRED INSURANCE at the time [it issues] the license IS ISSUED AND WITH EACH LICENSE RENEWAL.
16 17	(2) The licensee shall maintain the insurance protection for the period the license is in effect.
18 19	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2023.
