18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

(b) "Disability" means any defect or infirmity that may incapacitate an individual totally or partially for gainful employment or independent living.

1 (C) "DIVISION" MEANS THE DIVISION OF REHABILITATION SERVICES IN 2 THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

3 [(c)] (D) "Federal acts" means the rehabilitation acts of the United States 4 Congress.

5 [(d)] (E) "Rehabilitation" means the process of enabling a disabled individual to 6 become gainfully employed and to function more independently.

8 (A) BEGINNING ON OR BEFORE AUGUST 1, 2023, THE DIVISION SHALL 9 PUBLICLY POST ON THE DIVISION'S WEBSITE THE TOTAL NUMBER OF OPEN CASES 10 IN THE DIVISION'S CASELOAD.

11 (B) THE DIVISION SHALL UPDATE THE INFORMATION REQUIRED UNDER 12 SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION EVERY MONTH.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July14 1, 2023.
