### CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 ~~Public Utilities – Primary and Secondary Utility Account Holders – Domestic~~  
3 ~~Violence Victims of Abuse – Protections~~

4 FOR the purpose of ~~requiring a certain utility to release a primary or secondary account~~  
5 ~~holder who is the victim of domestic violence from a contract held with the utility~~  
6 ~~under certain circumstances~~ authorizing an account holder who is the victim of abuse  
7 to terminate, and requiring a utility to allow for the termination of, the account  
8 holder’s future liability under a utility contract under certain circumstances;  
9 requiring a utility to allow an account holder who terminates a utility contract under  
10 this Act to allow the account holder to open a new utility account for a new premises  
11 notwithstanding a certain account balance or arrearage; and generally relating to  
12 ~~public~~ utility accounts.

5 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
6 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

7 **Article – Public Utilities**

8 **5–502.**

9 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS  
10 INDICATED.

11 ~~(2) “PRIMARY ACCOUNT HOLDER” MEANS THE INDIVIDUAL IN WHOSE~~  
12 ~~NAME A UTILITY ACCOUNT IS ESTABLISHED.~~

13 ~~(3) “SECONDARY ACCOUNT HOLDER” MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS~~  
14 ~~LISTED ON A UTILITY ACCOUNT BUT WHO IS NOT THE PRIMARY ACCOUNT HOLDER.~~

15 (2) “ABUSE” HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 4–501(B) OF THE  
16 FAMILY LAW ARTICLE.

17 (3) “ACCOUNT HOLDER” MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL IN WHOSE NAME A  
18 UTILITY ACCOUNT IS MAINTAINED INDIVIDUALLY OR JOINTLY WITH OTHER  
19 INDIVIDUALS.

20 (4) “OFFENDER” MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO COMMITS AN ACT OF  
21 ABUSE.

22 (5) “QUALIFIED THIRD PARTY” MEANS:

23 (I) A LICENSED PHYSICIAN OR PSYCHOLOGIST AUTHORIZED TO  
24 PRACTICE UNDER THE HEALTH OCCUPATIONS ARTICLE;

25 (II) A SOCIAL WORKER OR CASEWORKER OF ANY PUBLIC OR  
26 PRIVATE HEALTH OR SOCIAL SERVICES AGENCY OR PROVIDER; OR

27 (III) AN ADVOCATE FROM A DOMESTIC VIOLENCE OR SEXUAL  
28 ASSAULT PREVENTION OR ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.

29 (6) “REPORT BY A QUALIFIED THIRD PARTY” MEANS A REPORT BASED  
30 ON INFORMATION RECEIVED BY A QUALIFIED THIRD PARTY WHILE ACTING IN A  
31 PROFESSIONAL CAPACITY THAT:

1           **(I) INDICATES THAT THE ACCOUNT HOLDER IS SEEKING**  
2 **ASSISTANCE AS A RESULT OF BEING A VICTIM OF ABUSE; AND**

3           **(II) INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**

4           **1. THE NAME OF THE ACCOUNT HOLDER;**

5           **2. THE DATE, TIME, LOCATION, AND A BRIEF**  
6 **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT;**

7           **3. THE NAME AND PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF THE**  
8 **ALLEGED OFFENDER, IF KNOWN;**

9           **4. THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE EMPLOYER OF THE**  
10 **QUALIFIED THIRD PARTY;**

11           **5. IF THE QUALIFIED THIRD PARTY IS REQUIRED TO BE**  
12 **LICENSED, THE LICENSING ENTITY AND LICENSE NUMBER OF THE QUALIFIED THIRD**  
13 **PARTY;**

14           **6. THE SIGNATURE OF THE QUALIFIED THIRD PARTY,**  
15 **UNDER SEAL OF A NOTARY PUBLIC; AND**

16           **7. THE ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND SIGNATURE OF THE**  
17 **ACCOUNT HOLDER UNDER PENALTY OF PERJURY.**

18           ~~(4)~~ **(7) “UTILITY” MEANS AN ELECTRIC COMPANY, AN ELECTRICITY**  
19 **SUPPLIER, A GAS COMPANY, A GAS SUPPLIER, A SEWAGE DISPOSAL COMPANY, A**  
20 **WATER COMPANY, OR ANY COMBINATION OF THESE COMPANIES.**

21           **(B) (1) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTIONS (C) AND (D) OF THIS SECTION, IF AN**  
22 **ACCOUNT HOLDER IS A VICTIM OF ABUSE, THE ACCOUNT HOLDER MAY TERMINATE,**  
23 **AND THE UTILITY SHALL ALLOW FOR THE TERMINATION OF, THE ACCOUNT**  
24 **HOLDER’S FUTURE LIABILITY UNDER A UTILITY CONTRACT IF THE ACCOUNT**  
25 **HOLDER PROVIDES THE UTILITY WITH WRITTEN NOTICE BY FIRST-CLASS MAIL OR**  
26 **HAND DELIVERY OF THE ACCOUNT HOLDER’S REQUEST FOR TERMINATION OF THE**  
27 **ACCOUNT HOLDER’S FUTURE LIABILITY UNDER THE CONTRACT.**

28           **(2) THE NOTICE REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS**  
29 **SUBSECTION SHALL INCLUDE:**

1                    (I) A COPY OF AN ENFORCEABLE FINAL ~~PEACE~~ *PROTECTIVE*  
 2 ORDER ISSUED FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE ACCOUNT HOLDER UNDER § 4-506 OF THE  
 3 FAMILY LAW ARTICLE;

4                    (II) A COPY OF AN ENFORCEABLE FINAL PEACE ORDER, FOR  
 5 WHICH THE UNDERLYING ACT WAS AN ACT OF ABUSE, ISSUED FOR THE BENEFIT OF  
 6 THE ACCOUNT HOLDER UNDER § 3-1505 OF THE COURTS ARTICLE; OR

7                    (III) A COPY OF A REPORT BY A QUALIFIED THIRD PARTY IF:

8                    1. THE NAME AND PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF THE  
 9 ALLEGED OFFENDER ARE REDACTED; AND

10                    2. THE REPORT WAS SIGNED BY THE QUALIFIED THIRD  
 11 PARTY WITHIN THE 60 DAYS IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING THE DATE THE NOTICE IS  
 12 PROVIDED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

13                    (C) AN ACCOUNT HOLDER WHO TERMINATES A UTILITY CONTRACT UNDER  
 14 SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION IS RESPONSIBLE FOR UTILITY CHARGES ONLY UP  
 15 TO AND INCLUDING THE BILLING CYCLE DURING WHICH THE WRITTEN NOTICE  
 16 REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION IS SUBMITTED.

17                    (D) IF AN ACCOUNT HOLDER TERMINATES A UTILITY CONTRACT UNDER  
 18 SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THE UTILITY SHALL ALLOW THE ACCOUNT  
 19 HOLDER TO OPEN A NEW UTILITY ACCOUNT FOR A NEW PREMISES  
 20 NOTWITHSTANDING AN ACCOUNT BALANCE OR ARREARAGE AT THE PREMISES  
 21 DESCRIBED IN THE WRITTEN NOTICE UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.

22                    ~~(B) (1) A UTILITY SHALL ALLOW A PRIMARY OR SECONDARY ACCOUNT~~  
 23 ~~HOLDER TO BE RELEASED FROM A CONTRACT WITHOUT INCURRING A FEE,~~  
 24 ~~PENALTY, OR CHARGE IF THE PRIMARY OR SECONDARY ACCOUNT HOLDER~~  
 25 ~~PROVIDES AN ATTESTATION IN WRITING OF THE ACCOUNT HOLDER'S STATUS AS A~~  
 26 ~~VICTIM OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE.~~

27                    ~~(2) THE WRITTEN ATTESTATION REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1)~~  
 28 ~~OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL INCLUDE:~~

29                    ~~(I) CERTIFIED FILES OR RECORDS FROM A COURT OR A LAW~~  
 30 ~~ENFORCEMENT AGENCY OR OTHER FEDERAL OR STATE AGENCY;~~

31                    ~~(II) DOCUMENTATION FROM A DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, SEXUAL~~  
 32 ~~ASSAULT, OR HUMAN TRAFFICKING PREVENTION OR ASSISTANCE PROGRAM~~  
 33 ~~INDICATING THAT THE PRIMARY OR SECONDARY ACCOUNT HOLDER PARTICIPATED~~

1 ~~(H) DOCUMENTATION FROM A RELIGIOUS, MEDICAL, OR OTHER~~  
2 ~~PROFESSIONAL FROM WHOM THE PRIMARY OR SECONDARY ACCOUNT HOLDER~~  
3 ~~SOUGHT ASSISTANCE OR TREATMENT AS A SURVIVOR OF THREATENED,~~  
4 ~~ATTEMPTED, OR ACTUAL DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, SEXUAL ASSAULT, STALKING,~~  
5 ~~HARASSMENT, OR HUMAN TRAFFICKING.~~

6 ~~(C) A UTILITY MAY NOT MAKE THE RELEASE FROM A CONTRACT UNDER~~  
7 ~~SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION CONTINGENT ON:~~

8 ~~(1) THE DISCLOSURE OF CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION OR ANY~~  
9 ~~FURTHER DETAILS ABOUT THE PRIMARY OR SECONDARY ACCOUNT HOLDER'S~~  
10 ~~STATUS AS A VICTIM OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE;~~

11 ~~(2) THE PRIMARY OR SECONDARY ACCOUNT HOLDER MAINTAINING A~~  
12 ~~CONTRACTUAL OR BILLING RESPONSIBILITY FOR A SEPARATED ACCOUNT WITH THE~~  
13 ~~PROVIDER;~~

14 ~~(3) THE PRIMARY ACCOUNT HOLDER APPROVING THE RELEASE IF~~  
15 ~~THE SECONDARY ACCOUNT HOLDER IS THE PERSON MAKING THE REQUEST; OR~~

16 ~~(4) A PAYMENT ON ARREARS ACCRUED BY THE ACCOUNT BEFORE THE~~  
17 ~~RELEASE REQUEST.~~

18 ~~(D) (1) A UTILITY SHALL RELEASE A PRIMARY OR SECONDARY ACCOUNT~~  
19 ~~HOLDER REQUESTING A RELEASE UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION NOT~~  
20 ~~LATER THAN 7 DAYS AFTER RECEIVING THE RELEASE REQUEST.~~

21 ~~(2) A UTILITY SHALL DISPOSE OF ANY WRITTEN ATTESTATION~~  
22 ~~PROVIDED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION:~~

23 ~~(I) NOT LATER THAN 30 DAYS AFTER RECEIVING THE~~  
24 ~~INFORMATION; AND~~

25 ~~(II) IN A MANNER THAT MAINTAINS THE CONFIDENTIALITY OF~~  
26 ~~THE PRIMARY OR SECONDARY ACCOUNT HOLDER.~~

27 ~~(E) A UTILITY SHALL MAKE INFORMATION ABOUT THE OPTIONS AND~~  
28 ~~PROCESS DESCRIBED UNDER THIS SECTION AVAILABLE TO CUSTOMERS ON ANY~~  
29 ~~WEBSITE, MOBILE APPLICATION, AND OTHER FORMS OF PUBLIC-FACING CUSTOMER~~

1            ~~(F) A UTILITY MAY NOT BE SUBJECT TO LIABILITY FOR ANY CLAIMS ARISING~~
