A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Public Utilities – Primary and Secondary Account Holders – Domestic Violence**
3 **Protections**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring a certain utility to release a primary or secondary account
5 holder who is the victim of domestic violence from a contract held with the utility
6 under certain circumstances; and generally relating to public utility accounts.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Public Utilities**

15 **5–502.**

16 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
17 INDICATED.

18 (2) “PRIMARY ACCOUNT HOLDER” MEANS THE INDIVIDUAL IN WHOSE
19 NAME A UTILITY ACCOUNT IS ESTABLISHED.

20 (3) “SECONDARY ACCOUNT HOLDER” MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS
21 LISTED ON A UTILITY ACCOUNT BUT WHO IS NOT THE PRIMARY ACCOUNT HOLDER.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 **(4) “UTILITY” MEANS AN ELECTRIC COMPANY, AN ELECTRICITY**
2 **SUPPLIER, A GAS COMPANY, A GAS SUPPLIER, A SEWAGE DISPOSAL COMPANY, A**
3 **WATER COMPANY, OR ANY COMBINATION OF THESE COMPANIES.**

4 **(B) (1) A UTILITY SHALL ALLOW A PRIMARY OR SECONDARY ACCOUNT**
5 **HOLDER TO BE RELEASED FROM A CONTRACT WITHOUT INCURRING A FEE,**
6 **PENALTY, OR CHARGE IF THE PRIMARY OR SECONDARY ACCOUNT HOLDER**
7 **PROVIDES AN ATTESTATION IN WRITING OF THE ACCOUNT HOLDER’S STATUS AS A**
8 **VICTIM OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE.**

9 **(2) THE WRITTEN ATTESTATION REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1)**
10 **OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL INCLUDE:**

11 **(I) CERTIFIED FILES OR RECORDS FROM A COURT OR A LAW**
12 **ENFORCEMENT AGENCY OR OTHER FEDERAL OR STATE AGENCY;**

13 **(II) DOCUMENTATION FROM A DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, SEXUAL**
14 **ASSAULT, OR HUMAN TRAFFICKING PREVENTION OR ASSISTANCE PROGRAM**
15 **INDICATING THAT THE PRIMARY OR SECONDARY ACCOUNT HOLDER PARTICIPATED**
16 **IN OR SOUGHT ASSISTANCE FROM THE PROGRAM; OR**

17 **(III) DOCUMENTATION FROM A RELIGIOUS, MEDICAL, OR OTHER**
18 **PROFESSIONAL FROM WHOM THE PRIMARY OR SECONDARY ACCOUNT HOLDER**
19 **SOUGHT ASSISTANCE OR TREATMENT AS A SURVIVOR OF THREATENED,**
20 **ATTEMPTED, OR ACTUAL DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, SEXUAL ASSAULT, STALKING,**
21 **HARASSMENT, OR HUMAN TRAFFICKING.**

22 **(C) A UTILITY MAY NOT MAKE THE RELEASE FROM A CONTRACT UNDER**
23 **SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION CONTINGENT ON:**

24 **(1) THE DISCLOSURE OF CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION OR ANY**
25 **FURTHER DETAILS ABOUT THE PRIMARY OR SECONDARY ACCOUNT HOLDER’S**
26 **STATUS AS A VICTIM OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE;**

27 **(2) THE PRIMARY OR SECONDARY ACCOUNT HOLDER MAINTAINING A**
28 **CONTRACTUAL OR BILLING RESPONSIBILITY FOR A SEPARATED ACCOUNT WITH THE**
29 **PROVIDER;**

30 **(3) THE PRIMARY ACCOUNT HOLDER APPROVING THE RELEASE IF**
31 **THE SECONDARY ACCOUNT HOLDER IS THE PERSON MAKING THE REQUEST; OR**

32 **(4) A PAYMENT ON ARREARS ACCRUED BY THE ACCOUNT BEFORE THE**
33 **RELEASE REQUEST.**

1 **(D) (1) A UTILITY SHALL RELEASE A PRIMARY OR SECONDARY ACCOUNT**
2 **HOLDER REQUESTING A RELEASE UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION NOT**
3 **LATER THAN 7 DAYS AFTER RECEIVING THE RELEASE REQUEST.**

4 **(2) A UTILITY SHALL DISPOSE OF ANY WRITTEN ATTESTATION**
5 **PROVIDED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION:**

6 **(I) NOT LATER THAN 30 DAYS AFTER RECEIVING THE**
7 **INFORMATION; AND**

8 **(II) IN A MANNER THAT MAINTAINS THE CONFIDENTIALITY OF**
9 **THE PRIMARY OR SECONDARY ACCOUNT HOLDER.**

10 **(E) A UTILITY SHALL MAKE INFORMATION ABOUT THE OPTIONS AND**
11 **PROCESS DESCRIBED UNDER THIS SECTION AVAILABLE TO CUSTOMERS ON ANY**
12 **WEBSITE, MOBILE APPLICATION, AND OTHER FORMS OF PUBLIC-FACING CUSTOMER**
13 **COMMUNICATION THE UTILITY MAINTAINS.**

14 **(F) A UTILITY MAY NOT BE SUBJECT TO LIABILITY FOR ANY CLAIMS ARISING**
15 **FROM AN ACTION TAKEN OR OMISSION MADE WITH RESPECT TO COMPLYING WITH**
16 **THIS SECTION.**

17 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect**
18 **October 1, 2023.**
