FOR the purpose of authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Frederick County to issue a Class B–GSF (golf simulator facility) license to a golf simulator facility under certain circumstances; authorizing the license holder to sell beer, wine, and liquor for on-premises consumption under certain circumstances; requiring the license holder to submit a certain report to the Board before a license may be renewed; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Frederick County.
