CHAPTER
AN ACT concerning
Cemeteries - <u>Interment -</u> Pet Remains — Duty of Perpetual Care
FOR the purpose of <u>making certain provisions of law governing cemeteries applicable to pet cemeteries;</u> providing that a certain registered cemeterian, registered crematory operator, or permit holder who sells or offers to sell to the public certain services for pet remains owes a duty of perpetual care for the cemetery in which certain pet remains are interred; <u>requiring the Director of the Office of Cemetery Oversight to adopt regulations to enforce certain provisions of this Act;</u> and generally relating to perpetual care for cemeteries that inter <u>the interment of pet remains</u> .
