  Transportation Trust Fund in certain fiscal years that the Governor is required to

  known as the Pride of Baltimore II; extending the fiscal years to which the mandated
  appropriation applies; and generally relating to operating funding for the Pride of
  Baltimore II.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

2 (a) For fiscal years [2020] **2024** through [2023] **2028**, the Governor shall include 3 in the annual State budget an appropriation of **{**\$500,000**} \$600,000** from the 4 Transportation Trust Fund for the operation of the replica sailing vessel known as the Pride 5 of Baltimore II.

6 (b) On or before December 1, [2019] **2023**, and on or before December 1 each year 7 thereafter, any person or entity receiving funds under this section shall submit a report to 8 the Department and, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, the 9 Senate Budget and Taxation Committee and the House Appropriations Committee that 10 includes:

11 (1) An accounting of how the funds were expended, supported by properly 12 executed records, receipts, vouchers, invoices, and contracts that evidence the nature of the 13 expenditures;

14 (2) An itinerary and any other information that demonstrates that the 15 Pride of Baltimore II was operated solely for the purposes of promoting historical maritime 16 education, fostering economic development and tourism, and representing the citizens of 17 Maryland in every port visited; and

- 18 (3) A strategic business plan that includes:

- (i) A goal to decrease or eliminate the need for State funds;
