 - [(c)] **(D)** To qualify for registration, a vocational evaluator shall:

 - (3) be certified or have met all of the educational and experience requirements to be eligible to be certified in vocational evaluation by the Commission on certification of work adjustment and vocational evaluation specialists, or have met all of the education and experience requirements to be eligible for certification.

- 12 (1) a rehabilitation counselor who has met the education requirements 13 under subsection **[(b)(1)] (C)(1)** or (2) of this section to qualify for registration shall work 14 under the administrative supervision of a certified rehabilitation counselor, certified 15 vocational evaluator, certified disability management specialist, certified case manager, or 16 certified rehabilitation registered nurse; and
- 17 (2) a vocational evaluator who has met the education requirements under 18 subsection [(c)(1)] (D)(1) or (2) of this section shall work under the administrative 19 supervision of a certified vocational evaluator, certified rehabilitation counselor, certified 20 disability management specialist, certified case manager, or certified rehabilitation 21 registered nurse.

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- 23 (c) If a permanent impairment involves a behavioral or mental disorder, a licensed psychologist, LICENSED CERTIFIED SOCIAL WORKER-CLINICAL, or qualified physician shall:
- 26 (1) perform an evaluation of only the mental or behavioral portion of the 27 permanent impairment; and
- 28 (2) report the evaluation to the Commission in accordance with the 29 regulations of the Commission.
- 30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 31 October 1, 2023.
