Public Health - Parkinson's Disease Registry - Established Advisory Committee and Website

FOR the purpose of establishing a Parkinson's Disease Registry in the Maryland 4 5 Department of Health; requiring the Department to collect certain data for the 6 Registry: authorizing the Department to share certain information in the Registry 7 with certain entities under certain conditions; providing for the confidentiality of 8 information collected under this Act; requiring the Department to maintain a record 9 of individuals granted access to confidential information in the Registry; altering the duties of the Parkinson's Disease Registry Advisory Committee; requiring the 10 11 Committee to meet on a certain basis beginning on a certain date, rather than with the frequency established by the Secretary of Health; requiring the Maryland 12 13 Department of Health, in collaboration with the State-designated health information exchange, to establish and maintain a certain website that has certain 14 information related to Parkinson's disease; and generally relating to the 15 16 establishment of a Parkinson's Disease Registry Parkinson's disease.
