FOR the purpose of altering the percentage reimbursement rate increase that is required $\mathbf{5}$ to be included in the Governor's proposed budget for a certain fiscal year for providers 6 of certain health care services under the Maryland Medical Assistance Program, the 7 Maryland Children's Health Program, and the Community First Choice Program; 8 requiring nursing homes to annually submit a certain cost report to the Maryland Department of Health; requiring that a certain percentage of the funding increase 9 for a certain fiscal year be used to fund wage increases for certain workers; and 1011 generally relating to the reimbursement of service providers under the Maryland 12Medical Assistance Program, the Maryland Children's Health Program, and the 13 Community First Choice Program.
