- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 Article Health General
- 14 **15–151.**
- 15 (A) UNLESS THE CHILD'S FAMILY HAS REQUESTED THAT THE CHILD BE
- 16 REMOVED, A CHILD ON THE REGISTRY FOR THE AUTISM WAIVER SHALL REMAIN ON
- 17 THE REGISTRY IF THE CHILD'S FAMILY RELOCATES OUT OF THE STATE FOR
- 18 MILITARY SERVICE.
- 19 (B) IF A CHILD ON THE REGISTRY FOR THE AUTISM WAIVER BECOMES
- 20 ELIGIBLE FOR SERVICES THROUGH THE WAIVER WHILE THE CHILD'S FAMILY IS OUT
- 21 OF THE STATE FOR MILITARY SERVICE, THE CHILD SHALL BE ELIGIBLE FOR
- 22 SERVICES THROUGH THE WAIVER IF THE FAMILY RELOCATES TO THE STATE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2023.
