15 (A) UNLESS THE CHILD'S FAMILY HAS REQUESTED THAT THE CHILD BE 16 REMOVED, A CHILD ON THE REGISTRY FOR THE AUTISM WAIVER SHALL REMAIN ON 17 THE REGISTRY IF THE CHILD'S FAMILY RELOCATES OUT OF THE STATE FOR 18 MILITARY SERVICE.

1 (B) IF A CHILD ON THE REGISTRY FOR THE AUTISM WAIVER BECOMES 2 ELIGIBLE FOR SERVICES THROUGH THE WAIVER WHILE THE CHILD'S FAMILY IS OUT 3 OF THE STATE FOR MILITARY SERVICE, THE CHILD SHALL BE ELIGIBLE FOR 4 SERVICES THROUGH THE WAIVER IF THE FAMILY RELOCATES TO THE STATE.
