A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Board of Elections – Procurement Oversight**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Administrator of Elections or the procurement
4 officer for the State Board of Elections to disclose requests for proposals, invitations
5 for bids, and proposed procurement contracts to the State Board; requiring the State
6 Board to vote to approve or reject certain requests for proposals, invitations for bids,
7 and procurement contracts; and generally relating to procurement oversight by the
8 State Board of Elections.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Election Law**

17 **2–110.**

18 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
19 INDICATED.

20 (2) “INVITATION FOR BIDS” HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 11–101
21 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.

22 (3) “PROCUREMENT” HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 11–101 OF THE
23 STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 **(4) “PROCUREMENT CONTRACT” HAS THE MEANING STATED IN §**
2 **11-101 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.**

3 **(5) “REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS” HAS THE MEANING STATED IN §**
4 **11-101 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.**

5 **(B) (1) BEFORE ISSUING A REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS OR AN INVITATION**
6 **FOR BIDS, THE STATE ADMINISTRATOR OR THE PROCUREMENT OFFICER FOR THE**
7 **STATE BOARD SHALL DISCLOSE THE REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS OR INVITATION FOR**
8 **BIDS TO THE STATE BOARD.**

9 **(2) BEFORE EXECUTING A PROCUREMENT CONTRACT, THE STATE**
10 **ADMINISTRATOR OR THE PROCUREMENT OFFICER FOR THE STATE BOARD SHALL**
11 **DISCLOSE THE PROPOSED PROCUREMENT CONTRACT TO THE STATE BOARD.**

12 **(C) (1) THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A PROCUREMENT MADE:**

13 **(I) LESS THAN 45 DAYS BEFORE THE DATE OF A PRIMARY**
14 **ELECTION OR GENERAL ELECTION; AND**

15 **(II) USING EMERGENCY PROCUREMENT PROCEDURES**
16 **PROVIDED UNDER § 13-108 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.**

17 **(2) IF A PLANNED REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS OR AN INVITATION FOR**
18 **BIDS RELATES TO A CONTRACT THAT IS REASONABLY EXPECTED TO EXCEED**
19 **\$200,000, THE STATE BOARD SHALL VOTE TO APPROVE OR REJECT THE PLANNED**
20 **REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS OR INVITATION FOR BIDS BEFORE THE STATE**
21 **ADMINISTRATOR OR PROCUREMENT OFFICER FOR THE STATE BOARD MAY ISSUE**
22 **THE REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS OR INVITATION FOR BIDS.**

23 **(3) IF A PROPOSED PROCUREMENT CONTRACT HAS A VALUE**
24 **GREATER THAN \$200,000, THE STATE BOARD SHALL VOTE TO APPROVE OR REJECT**
25 **THE PROPOSED PROCUREMENT CONTRACT BEFORE THE STATE ADMINISTRATOR**
26 **OR PROCUREMENT OFFICER FOR THE STATE BOARD MAY SUBMIT THE PROPOSED**
27 **PROCUREMENT CONTRACT TO THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS FOR APPROVAL.**

28 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
29 October 1, 2023.
