2	Alcoholic Beverages - Retail Delivery - Alterations and Third-Party Delivery

FOR the purpose of establishing a delivery service permit that authorizes the holder to 4 5 deliver alcoholic beverages from a certain retail license holder authorized to deliver 6 alcoholic beverages to purchasers in the State under certain circumstances; 7 authorizing certain retail license holders to deliver alcoholic beverages to purchasers 8 in the State through a third-party contractor, an independent contractor, or an agent 9 that holds a delivery service permit under certain circumstances; altering certain standards and requirements for the retail delivery of alcoholic beverages; and 10 11 generally relating to retail delivery of alcoholic beverages.
