## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Montgomery County – Speed Monitoring Systems – Authorized Highways**

3 **MC 6–23**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the highways in Montgomery County on which the placement  
5 of speed monitoring systems is authorized; and generally relating to speed  
6 monitoring systems in Montgomery County.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Transportation**

15 21–809.

16 (b) (1) (vi) This section applies to a violation of this subtitle recorded by a  
17 speed monitoring system that meets the requirements of this subsection and has been  
18 placed:

19 1. In Montgomery County [or Prince George’s County], on a  
20 highway [in a residential district, as defined in § 21–101 of this title,] with a maximum  
21 posted speed limit of [35] 45 miles per hour, which speed limit was established using  
22 generally accepted traffic engineering practices;
