1 (i) Twice the amount of the [total fees] **FEE** normally charged or 2 authorized by the political subdivision for the public safety impound towing of vehicles;

3 (ii) Notwithstanding § 16–207(f)(1) of the Commercial Law Article,
4 the fee normally charged or authorized by the political subdivision from which the vehicle
5 was towed for the daily storage of impounded vehicles;

6 (iii) If a political subdivision does not establish a fee limit for the 7 public safety towing, recovery, or storage of impounded vehicles, \$250 for towing and 8 recovering a vehicle and \$30 per day for vehicle storage; and

9 (iv) Subject to subsection (b) of this section, the actual cost of 10 providing notice under this section;

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 12 October 1, 2023.
