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Environment – Septic Systems – Online Database

- FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of the Environment to develop and maintain a certain online database of all septic systems installed in the State to track certain information; requiring a local jurisdiction to report certain information to the Department in a certain manner; requiring the Department to establish a workgroup to oversee the development and population of the database; and generally relating to an online database for septic systems.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
