20 21	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 2 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 3 INDICATED.
- 4 (2) "BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT" MEANS A BUSINESS
- 5 IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT ESTABLISHED UNDER TITLE 12, SUBTITLE 4 OF THE
- 6 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ARTICLE.
- 7 (3) "COMMERCIAL PROPERTY" MEANS IMPROVED OR UNIMPROVED
- 8 REAL PROPERTY ZONED FOR COMMERCIAL, INDUSTRIAL, OR NONRESIDENTIAL USE
- 9 BY THE LOCAL ZONING AUTHORITY OF A COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY IN WHICH THE
- 10 PROPERTY IS LOCATED.
- 11 (4) "ELIGIBLE TRANSIT-ORIENTED DEVELOPMENT" MEANS A
- 12 TRANSIT-ORIENTED DEVELOPMENT, AS DEFINED IN § 7-101(M) OF THE
- 13 TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE, LOCATED IN A BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT IN

- 15 (B) (1) BEFORE THE SALE OF A COMMERCIAL PROPERTY IN AN ELIGIBLE
