16 17	(a) (1) (I) Except as provided under paragraph (2) of this subsection, all issues of law shall be referred by the Director to the panel chairman.
18 19	(II) All issues of fact shall be referred by the Director to the arbitration panel.
20 21 22 23	(2) Where a panel chairman has not been appointed or is temporarily unable to serve, and the Director is admitted to the Maryland Bar, the Director may rule on all issues of law arising prior to hearing [that are not dispositive of the case and shall include], INCLUDING the assessment of costs.

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SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2023.
