
## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning 2 State Board of Electricians - Limited Energy Contractors and Limited Energy 3 Integrators - Licensing 4 FOR the purpose of altering the composition of the State Board of Electricians; requiring 5 the Board to license limited energy contractors and limited energy integrators as 6 State licenses; and generally relating to the State Board of Electricians and limited 7 energy contractors and limited energy integrators. 8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, 9 Article – Business Occupations and Professions 10 Section 6–101, 6–103, 6–202, 6–302, 6–303, 6–308(a), 6–316(a), 6–319, 6–320, 6–321, 11 6-501, 6-504(a) and (b), 6-601(a), and 6-602 through 6-607 Annotated Code of Maryland 12 (2018 Replacement Volume and 2022 Supplement) 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 14 15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 16 **Article – Business Occupations and Professions** 17 6-101.18 In this title the following words have the meanings indicated. (a) 19 (1) "Assignment of local registration" means any procedure by which a 20 licensee or registrant grants to another person a right to use a local registration to enable 21that person to engage in the business of providing electrical services. 22 (2)"Assignment of local registration" includes any procedure by which:



- 28 (P) "PROVIDE LIMITED ENERGY SERVICES" MEANS TO INSTALL, SERVICE, 29 MAINTAIN, DESIGN, OR REPAIR LIMITED ENERGY SYSTEMS.

(b) If a local jurisdiction registers any class of electricians other than master electricians, journeyperson electricians, or apprentice electricians, that class is also under the control and supervision of the local board.

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- 4 (c) (1) [Beginning July 1, 2021, a] A local jurisdiction may not issue licenses for apprentice, journeyperson, or master electricians, LIMITED ENERGY CONTRACTORS, 6 OR LIMITED ENERGY INTEGRATORS.
- 7 (2)**(I)** A local jurisdiction that licensed apprentice-level, 8 journeyperson-level, or master-level electricians before July 1, 2021, may continue to 9 register the electricians according to the same rules and requirements for licenses issued before July 1, 2021, if the local jurisdiction complies with subsections (d) and (e) of this 10 11 section.
- (II) A LOCAL JURISDICTION THAT LICENSED LIMITED ENERGY
  CONTRACTORS OR LIMITED ENERGY INTEGRATORS BEFORE JULY 1, 2023, MAY




