- 4 **[**(c)**]** (3) A person is subject to a fine of \$50 for each coyote, fox, or raccoon killed in violation of [subsection (a)] PARAGRAPH (1) of this [section] SUBSECTION.
- 6 (B) (1) TO MANAGE THE DEER POPULATION IN THE STATE, THE 7 DEPARTMENT MAY ALLOW A PERSON TO SPONSOR, CONDUCT, OR PARTICIPATE IN 8 AN EXISTING, RANDOM CONTEST IN THE STATE HELD DURING THE MONTH OF JANUARY THAT HAS THE OBJECTIVE OF HARVESTING A FEMALE DEER.
- 10 (2) RANDOM LOTTERY AWARDS UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS 11 SUBSECTION SHALL BE LIMITED TO THREE INDIVIDUALS PER CONTEST.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 13 1, 2023.
