## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Frederick County – Alcoholic Beverages – Sunday Sales**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the hours during which a licensee may sell alcoholic beverages  
4 on Sundays in Frederick County; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in  
5 Frederick County.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,  
7 Article – Alcoholic Beverages  
8 Section 20–102, 20–1004(a), 20–1007(a), 20–1009(a), 20–1009.1(a), and 20–1009.2(a)  
9 Annotated Code of Maryland  
10 (2016 Volume and 2022 Supplement)

11 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
12 Article – Alcoholic Beverages  
13 Section 20–1004(d), 20–1007(d), 20–1009(e), 20–1009.1(e), 20–1009.2(g), 20–2002,  
14 20–2004, and 20–2005  
15 Annotated Code of Maryland

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

6 following day]; and

7 (2) on Sunday, from 11 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day].

9 (a) There is a Class B-DT (dinner theater) beer, wine, and liquor license.

10 (d) A license holder may sell beer, wine, and liquor beginning 2 hours before a live  
11 performance until the end of the performance[:

12 (1) on Monday through [Saturday; and

13 (2) on or after 1 p.m. on] Sunday.

14 20-1009.

15 (a) There is a Class EC (entertainment center) license.

16 (e) The [hours of sale are:

17 (1) on Monday through Saturday, from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day;

18 and

19 (2) on Sunday, from 11 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day] **LICENSE HOLDER**  
20 **MAY SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR DURING THE HOURS AND DAYS AS SET OUT FOR**  
21 **A CLASS B BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE UNDER § 20-2005 OF THIS TITLE.**

23 (a) There is a hotel lobby license.

24 (e) The license holder may sell beer and wine[:

25 (1) on Monday through Saturday, from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day;

26 and

1 (2) on Sunday, from 11 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day] **DURING THE**  
2 **HOURS AND DAYS AS SET OUT FOR A CLASS B BEER AND WINE LICENSE UNDER §**  
3 **20–2004 OF THIS TITLE.**

5 (a) This section applies only to a municipal golf course that is operated by a  
6 municipal golf course manager or a golf course manager under a management agreement  
7 with the City of Frederick.

8 (g) The [hours of sale are:

10 (2) on Sunday, from 10 a.m. to 10 p.m.] **LICENSE HOLDER MAY SELL**  
11 **BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR DURING THE HOURS AND DAYS AS SET OUT FOR A CLASS**  
12 **B BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE UNDER § 20–2005 OF THIS TITLE.**

25 is granted, the privilege shall be incorporated into the license.

27 (i) on Monday through [Saturday] **SUNDAY**, for on– and  
28 off–premises consumption, from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day[; and

29 (ii) on Sunday:

20 the event that are set by the Board].

22 (a) (1) A holder of a Class A beer, wine, and liquor license may sell beer, wine,  
23 and liquor on Monday through Saturday, from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day.

24 (2) (i) The Board may grant a special Sunday opening permit to the  
25 license holder.

26 (ii) The permit authorizes the holder to sell beer, wine, and liquor  
27 for off-premises consumption on Sunday from [10 a.m.] **6 A.M.** to 2 a.m. the following day.

1 (iii) The annual permit fee is \$650 in addition to the annual fee for  
2 the license.

3 (iv) The permit is not considered a separate class of license and, if it  
4 is granted, the privilege shall be incorporated into the license.

5 (b) [(1)] A holder of a Class B beer, wine, and liquor license may sell beer, wine,  
6 and liquor:

7 [(i)] (1) on Monday through Saturday, for on- and off-premises  
8 consumption, from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day; and

9 [(ii)] (2) on Sunday:

10 [1.] (I) [subject to paragraph (2) of this subsection,] for  
11 on-premises consumption:

12 [A.] 1. from [10 a.m.] **6 A.M.** to 2 a.m. the following day; or

13 [B.] 2. for a specific event that the Board has approved, the  
14 hours for the event that are set by the Board; and

15 [2.] (II) for off-premises consumption, from 1 p.m. to 2 a.m.  
16 the following day.

17 [(2) The license holder may not sell beer, wine, or liquor at a bar or counter  
18 on Sunday.]

19 (c) A holder of a Class B beer, wine, and liquor license in the Ballenger (23rd)  
20 election district may sell beer, wine, and liquor[:

21 (1) on Monday through [Saturday] **SUNDAY**, from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. the  
22 following day[: and

23 (2) on Sunday, from 10 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day].

24 (d) A holder of a Class C beer, wine, and liquor license may sell beer, wine, and  
25 liquor for on- and off-premises consumption[:

26 (1) on Monday through [Saturday] **SUNDAY**, from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. the  
27 following day[: and

28 (2) on Sunday:

29 (i) from 10 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day; or

1 (ii) for a specific event that the Board has approved, the hours for  
2 the event that are set by the Board].

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
4 1, 2023.
