## Maryland Native Plants Program

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Maryland Native Plants Program to encourage and 4 promote the use and sale of plants native to Maryland at certain businesses and to 5 educate the public on native plants; requiring the University of Maryland Extension 6 Department of Agriculture to administer the Program in coordination with the 7 Department of Agriculture University of Maryland Extension; requiring the University of Maryland Extension to hire an extension agent to serve as a native 8 9 plant specialist for certain educational purposes; requiring the Department of 10 Agriculture to create and maintain a certain voluntary certification program and a 11 marketing program in a certain manner; requiring the University of Maryland 12 Extension to create a certain website on native plants and requiring the Department 13 of Natural Resources to include a link to the website on the Department of Natural 14 Resources' native plants website; and generally relating to plants native to Maryland. 15
