- FOR the purpose of establishing the School Psychologist Recruitment Program within the
 State Department of Education; requiring the Program to provide professional
 development programs and aid for a certain certification fee to school psychologists
 and individuals seeking to become school psychologists and to reimburse school
 psychologists for professional conference expenses; and generally relating to the
 School Psychologist Recruitment Program.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND.
- 15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
- 19 INDICATED.
- 20 (2) "PROGRAM" MEANS THE SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST RECRUITMENT
- 21 PROGRAM.

- 4 (B) (1) THERE IS A SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST RECRUITMENT PROGRAM 5 WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT.
- 6 (2) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO PROVIDE PROFESSIONAL
 7 SUPPORT TO SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGISTS IN THE STATE AND INDIVIDUALS SEEKING TO
 8 BECOME SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGISTS IN THE STATE.
- 9 (C) (1) THE PROGRAM SHALL PROVIDE PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT 10 PROGRAMS TO INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE, OR ARE SEEKING TO BECOME, SCHOOL 11 PSYCHOLOGISTS.
- 12 (2) PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT MAY INCLUDE:
- 13 (I) VIRTUAL COURSES OR WEBINARS;
- 14 (II) MENTORING OR PEER COLLABORATION PROGRAMS; AND
- 15 (III) THE PROVISION OF SUPPORT MATERIALS.
- 16 (3) IN PROVIDING PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT TO SCHOOL 17 PSYCHOLOGISTS, THE PROGRAM SHALL:
- 18 (I) MAINTAIN A CLEARINGHOUSE OF SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST
- 19 BEST PRACTICES TO SUPPORT PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT OF SCHOOL
- 20 PSYCHOLOGISTS:
- 21 (II) COMMUNICATE AND PROMOTE UPCOMING OPPORTUNITIES
- 22 AND AVAILABLE RESOURCES TO SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGISTS; AND
- 23 (III) SEEK TO PROVIDE SUPPORT TO SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGISTS
- 24 FROM GROUPS HISTORICALLY UNDERREPRESENTED AMONG PROFESSIONAL
- 25 PERSONNEL IN THE STATE.
- 26 (D) (1) THE PROGRAM SHALL REIMBURSE SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGISTS FOR
- 27 ATTENDING PROFESSIONAL CONFERENCES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS
- 28 SUBSECTION.
- 29 (2) A SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST SHALL SUBMIT TO THE PROGRAM AN 30 APPLICATION FOR REIMBURSEMENT ON A FORM PROVIDED BY THE PROGRAM THAT

1 INCLUDES THE SUBMISSION OF:

- 2 (I) MATERIALS ON THE PROFESSIONAL CONFERENCE AND AN
- 3 EXPLANATION OF ITS RELEVANCE TO THE SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST'S PROFESSION;
- 4 **AND**
- 5 (II) RECEIPTS OR OTHER DOCUMENTATION OF THE EXPENSES
- 6 FOR WHICH THE SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST REQUESTS TO BE REIMBURSED.
- 7 (3) SUBJECT TO FUNDING AVAILABILITY, THE PROGRAM SHALL
- 8 APPROVE AN APPLICANT TO RECEIVE REIMBURSEMENT UNDER THIS SUBSECTION
- 9 **IF:**
- 10 (I) THE APPLICATION IS COMPLETE AND IS RECEIVED NOT
- 11 LATER THAN 180 DAYS AFTER THE LAST DAY OF THE CONFERENCE;
- 12 (II) THE AMOUNT REQUESTED DOES NOT EXCEED AN AMOUNT
- 13 DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT BY REGULATION; AND
- 14 (III) THE APPLICANT IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE A
- 15 REIMBURSEMENT.
- 16 (E) (1) (I) SUBJECT TO SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH,
- 17 EACH YEAR, THE PROGRAM SHALL SELECT, CONSISTENT WITH THE AMOUNT
- 18 PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET FOR THE PROGRAM, A MAXIMUM OF 100
- 19 INDIVIDUALS FOR WHOM THE PROGRAM SHALL PROVIDE FUNDS TO PAY THE
- 20 CERTIFICATION FEE CHARGED BY THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF SCHOOL
- 21 PSYCHOLOGISTS.
- 22 (II) IN SELECTING INDIVIDUALS UNDER THIS PARAGRAPH, THE
- 23 PROGRAM SHALL GIVE PRIORITY TO SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGISTS FROM GROUPS
- 24 HISTORICALLY UNDERREPRESENTED AMONG PROFESSIONAL PERSONNEL IN THE
- 25 **STATE.**
- 26 (2) (I) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO DOES NOT COMPLETE ALL THE
- 27 REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTIFICATION BY THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF SCHOOL
- 28 PSYCHOLOGISTS SHALL REIMBURSE THE PROGRAM THE FULL AMOUNT OF THE AID
- 29 RECEIVED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.
- 30 (II) THE PROVISIONS OF SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS
- 31 PARAGRAPH DO NOT APPLY TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO COMPLETES ALL THE
- 32 REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTIFICATION BY THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF SCHOOL
- 33 PSYCHOLOGISTS BUT WHO DOES NOT RECEIVE CERTIFICATION.

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- 1 (3) THE PROGRAM MAY PROVIDE AID TO AN INDIVIDUAL UNDER THIS 2 SUBSECTION FOR UP TO TWO APPLICATIONS FOR CERTIFICATION BY THE NATIONAL
- 3 ASSOCIATION OF SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGISTS.
- 4 (F) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS 5 SECTION, INCLUDING:
- 6 (1) THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT THE PROGRAM MAY REIMBURSE UNDER 7 SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION;
- 8 (2) PROCEDURES FOR AN INDIVIDUAL TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION 9 TO THE PROGRAM; AND
- 10 (3) CRITERIA FOR THE SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS OF AID UNDER 11 THE PROGRAM.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2023.
