Maryland Medical Assistance Program – Hospitals – Dental Services

- FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Department of Health to require an acute care hospital that participates in the Maryland Medical Assistance Program to develop a plan that demonstrates a commitment by the hospital to provide certain operating room time for certain dental services; requiring, on or before a certain date each year, each acute hospital to submit the plan to the Secretary of Health for approval; and generally relating to dental services provided by hospitals participating in the Maryland Medical Assistance Program.
