AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read 1 2 as follows: 3 Article - Alcoholic Beverages 20-102.This title applies only in Frederick County. 5 20-1009.2. 6 7 THERE IS A CLASS B-MGC (MINIATURE GOLF COURSE) BEER, WINE, 8 AND LIQUOR LICENSE. 9 (B) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE THE LICENSE FOR USE BY A MINIATURE GOLF 10 **COURSE THAT:** 11 **(1)** IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC; 12 **(2)** HAS A MINIATURE COURSE OF AT LEAST 18 HOLES; AND 13 **(3)** HAS ACCOMMODATIONS THAT ARE PREDOMINANTLY DEDICATED 14 TO MINIATURE GOLF. AN APPLICANT FOR A CLASS B-MGC (MINIATURE GOLF COURSE) BEER, 15 16 WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE SHALL SUBMIT TO THE BOARD A FLOOR PLAN OR 17 LAYOUT OF THE PROPOSED LICENSED PREMISES THAT ILLUSTRATES THAT THE 18 PROPOSED LICENSED PREMISES IS PREDOMINANTLY DEDICATED TO MINIATURE GOLF. 19 20 THE LICENSE HOLDER MAY SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR FOR 21**ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION:** 22 IF THE LICENSE HOLDER OFFERS FOOD ON-PREMISES AT ALL **(1)** 23 TIMES WHEN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE BEING SOLD; AND **(2)** 24DURING NORMAL BUSINESS HOURS AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2520-2005 OF THIS TITLE. THE LICENSE HOLDER'S ANNUAL SALES FROM: 26 **(E) (1)**
- 27 (I) ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES MAY NOT EXCEED 35% OF THE 28 ANNUAL GROSS SALES OF THE MINIATURE GOLF COURSE;

- 5 (2) BEFORE THE BOARD MAY RENEW A CLASS B-MGC (MINIATURE GOLF COURSE) BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE, THE LICENSE HOLDER SHALL PROVIDE THE BOARD WITH AN ANNUAL GROSS SALES REPORT FOR ALCOHOL, MINIATURE GOLF GAMES, AND FOOD THAT SHOWS THE LICENSE HOLDER HAS MET THE REQUIREMENTS OF PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.
- 10 **(F)** THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$1,500.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2023.
