| 14 15 | SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND. That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: |

| 18 19 | (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED. |
| 20 21 22 | (2) "ELIGIBLE GRADUATE" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE PROGRAM ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBSECTION (D)(2) OF THIS SECTION. |



- 1 (3) "PROGRAM" MEANS THE BALTIMORE CITY WORKFORCE 2 DEVELOPMENT AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE SUBSIDY PROGRAM.
- 3 (B) (1) THERE IS A BALTIMORE CITY WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT 4 AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE SUBSIDY PROGRAM IN THE DIVISION.
- 5 (2) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO PROVIDE SUBSIDIES FOR 6 PRIVATE PASSENGER AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE TO ELIGIBLE GRADUATES IN 7 ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION.
- 8 (C) THE DIVISION SHALL ADMINISTER THE PROGRAM.
- 9 **(D) (1)** THE PROGRAM SHALL PROVIDE A PRIVATE PASSENGER 10 AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE PREMIUM SUBSIDY TO ELIGIBLE GRADUATES IN AN 11 AMOUNT OF \$150 PER MONTH.
- 12 (2) TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE PROGRAM, AN INDIVIDUAL MUST:
- 13 (I) RESIDE IN BALTIMORE CITY;
- 14 (II) HAVE GRADUATED FROM A TRAINING PROGRAM THAT:
- 1. IS LOCATED IN BALTIMORE CITY;
- 16 **2.** DEMONSTRATES AN ABILITY TO PROVIDE 17 VOCATIONAL TRAINING ON AN ONGOING BASIS; AND
- 3. IS REGISTERED OR LICENSED IN THE STATE TO PROVIDE VOCATIONAL TRAINING:
- 20 (III) HAVE A VALID STATE DRIVER'S LICENSE AT THE TIME OF 21 APPLICATION;
- 22 (IV) BE AT LEAST 19 YEARS OLD AT THE TIME OF APPLICATION;
- 23 AND
- 24 (V) CARRY OR SEEK TO CARRY PRIVATE PASSENGER
- 25 AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE FROM AN INSURER LICENSED TO ISSUE MOTOR VEHICLE
- 26 INSURANCE IN THE STATE.
- 27 (3) THE DIVISION MAY ARRANGE FOR SUBSIDY PAYMENTS UNDER
- 28 THE PROGRAM TO BE REMITTED DIRECTLY TO MOTOR VEHICLE INSURERS.

| 1 2 3 | (4) IF AN ELIGIBLE GRADUATE AWARDED A SUBSIDY UNDER THE PROGRAM WISHES TO CONTINUE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM, THE ELIGIBLE GRADUATE MUST APPLY TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM EACH FISCAL YEAR. |
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| 4 5 6 | (E) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN APPROPRIATION OF \$5,000,000 FOR THE PROGRAM. |

| 8 | (1) APPLICATION PROCEDURES; |
| 9 10 | (2) CRITERIA FOR SETTING PRIORITIES FOR APPLICATIONS UNDER THE PROGRAM; |
| 11 | (3) PROCEDURES FOR AWARDING SUBSIDIES UNDER THE PROGRAM; |
| 12 13 | (4) PROCEDURES FOR THE DISTRIBUTION OF SUBSIDIES TO ELIGIBLE GRADUATES OR MOTOR VEHICLE INSURERS, AS APPROPRIATE; AND |
| 14 15 | (5) ANY OTHER PROCEDURES OR CRITERIA NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THIS SECTION. |
| 16 17 18 19 | (G) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1 EACH YEAR, BEGINNING IN 2025, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL SUBMIT TO THE GOVERNOR AND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1257 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY A REPORT THAT INCLUDES, FOR THE MOST RECENT CLOSED FISCAL YEAR: |

| 26 27 28 | SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2023. It shall remain effective for a period of 6 years and, at the end of September 30, 2029, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be |

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abrogated and of no further force and effect.
