State Highway Administration – Vegetation Management – Pollinator Habitat Plan

 requiring the Administration to apply for certain federal funding; and generally
 relating to pollinator-friendly vegetation management.

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 (A) (1) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL DEVELOP A POLLINATOR HABITAT 18 PLAN, AS REQUIRED UNDER § 2–1801 OF THE AGRICULTURE ARTICLE, FOR THE 19 MAINTENANCE OF VEGETATED AREAS ALONG STATE HIGHWAYS.

20 (2) IN ADDITION TO THE POLLINATOR HABITAT PLAN, THE 21 ADMINISTRATION SHALL ADOPT POLICIES AND PROCEDURES:

22 (I) TO ENCOURAGE THE USE OF POLLINATOR-FRIENDLY 23 NATIVE PLANTS ALONG STATE HIGHWAYS;



1 (II) FOR REDUCING, TO THE EXTENT FEASIBLE AND IN 2 ACCORDANCE WITH RELEVANT SAFETY STANDARDS FOR DRIVERS, BICYCLISTS, AND 3 PEDESTRIANS, THE SIZE OF THE AREAS MOWED ALONG STATE HIGHWAYS; AND

4 (III) FOR EDUCATING AND COMMUNICATING WITH THE PUBLIC 5 ABOUT POLLINATOR-FRIENDLY HABITATS AND MOWING PRACTICES ALONG STATE 6 HIGHWAYS.

7 (3) THE POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR EDUCATING AND
8 COMMUNICATING WITH THE PUBLIC UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION
9 MAY INCLUDE:

10 (I) PLACING AND MAINTAINING, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ANY 11 APPLICABLE PROVISIONS IN SUBTITLE 7 OF THIS TITLE, INFORMATIONAL SIGNS 12 ALONG STATE HIGHWAYS;

13(II) PUBLISHING INFORMATION ON THE WEBSITE OF THE14ADMINISTRATION AND SOCIAL MEDIA PLATFORMS; AND

15(III) OUTREACH TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC, COMMUNITY16ASSOCIATIONS, AND ELECTED OFFICIALS.

(B) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL APPLY FOR FEDERAL FUNDING THAT MAY
 BE USED TO SUPPORT THE USE OF POLLINATOR-FRIENDLY NATIVE PLANTS ALONG
 STATE HIGHWAYS.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 21 October 1, 2023.
