- 1 (1) IF A RESIDENTIAL LOT WITHIN THE VILLAGE COMMUNITY 2 ASSOCIATION IS OWNED BY MORE THAN ONE PERSON, EACH OWNER OF THE LOT IS 3 ENTITLED TO ONE VOTE IN THE ELECTION; AND
- 4 (2) IF THE VILLAGE COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION ALLOWS LESSEES TO
 5 VOTE IN THE ELECTION, AND A RESIDENTIAL LEASEHOLD WITHIN THE VILLAGE
 6 COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION IS HELD BY MORE THAN ONE LESSEE, EACH HOLDER OF
 7 THE LEASEHOLD IS ENTITLED TO ONE VOTE IN THE ELECTION.
- 8 (C) THIS SECTION DOES NOT LIMIT THE AUTHORITY OF A VILLAGE
 9 COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION TO ALLOW PERSONS TO VOTE IN AN ELECTION FOR THE
 10 VILLAGE BOARD OR THE COLUMBIA COUNCIL IN ADDITION TO THE PERSONS WHOM
 11 THE VILLAGE COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION MUST ALLOW TO VOTE UNDER SUBSECTION
 12 (B) OF THIS SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2023.
