- 1 AN ACT concerning
- 2 Department of State Police Training Facilities With Firearm Range Location
- 3 FOR the purpose of stating the intent of the General Assembly regarding the location of
- 4 Department of State Police training facilities with firearm ranges; requiring the
- 5 Governor to appropriate funds in the annual budget bill in certain years for the
- planning and relocation of certain training facilities of the Department; and
- 7 generally relating to training facilities of the Department of State Police with firearm

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND.
- 15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 16 Article Public Safety
- 17 2–303.
- 18 (a) As provided in the State budget, the Department shall make its training
- 19 facilities available to any law enforcement agency of the State and to the Police Training
- 20 and Standards Commission to the extent that the training facilities and employees of the
- 21 Department are available.
- 22 (b) The Secretary shall adopt rules to govern:
- 23 (1) the extent to which the training facilities of the Department may be
- 24 used;



- 1 (2) the course of training; and
- 2 (3) the qualifications of individuals who will use the training facilities.
- 3 (C) IT IS THE INTENT OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY THAT THE DEPARTMENT
- 4 MAY NOT LOCATE A TRAINING FACILITY WITH A FIREARM RANGE NEAR ANY
- 5 BUILDING, GROUNDS, PARKING LOT, OR OPEN SPACE OWNED OR OCCUPIED BY ANY
- 6 OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 7 (1) A HOSPITAL, AS DEFINED UNDER § 19–301 OF THE
- 8 HEALTH GENERAL ARTICLE;
- 9 (2) AN EDUCATIONAL FACILITY INCLUDING A CHILDCARE FACILITY,
- 10 PUBLIC PLAYGROUND, PRESCHOOL, PUBLIC OR PRIVATE SCHOOL, COLLEGE, OR
- 11 UNIVERSITY;
- 12 (3) A STATE OR LOCAL CORRECTIONAL FACILITY; OR
- 13 (4) A JUVENILE FACILITY.
- 14 (D) (1) IN FISCAL YEARS 2025 THROUGH 2029, EACH YEAR THE
- 15 GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN AMOUNT SUFFICIENT
- 16 FOR THE PLANNING AND CONSTRUCTION OF A TRAINING FACILITY OF THE
- 17 DEPARTMENT THAT SATISFIES THE INTENT OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY UNDER
- 18 SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION.
- 19 (2) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 15, 2023, AND EACH DECEMBER 15
- 20 THROUGH DECEMBER 15, 2029, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO
- 21 THE GOVERNOR AND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1257 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT
- 22 ARTICLE, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON THE FOLLOWING:
- 23 (I) THE TOTAL NUMBER OF TRAINING FACILITIES WITH
- 24 FIREARM RANGES OWNED OR USED BY THE DEPARTMENT NEAR A HOSPITAL, AN
- 25 EDUCATIONAL FACILITY, A STATE OR LOCAL CORRECTIONAL FACILITY, OR A
- 26 JUVENILE FACILITY;
- 27 (II) THE COST TO RELOCATE OR REPLACE A FACILITY
- 28 IDENTIFIED UNDER ITEM (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH TO AN AREA AWAY FROM A
- 29 HOSPITAL, AN EDUCATIONAL FACILITY, A STATE OR LOCAL CORRECTIONAL
- 30 FACILITY, OR A JUVENILE FACILITY;
- 31 (III) DATA ON TRAUMA AND RELATED OUTCOMES DUE TO THE
- 32 LOCATION OF FIREARM RANGES NEAR A HOSPITAL, AN EDUCATIONAL FACILITY, A

- 1 STATE OR LOCAL CORRECTIONAL FACILITY, OR A JUVENILE FACILITY;
- 2 (IV) GUNSHOT DECIBEL AND DISTANCE THRESHOLDS FOR
- 3 PHYSICAL AND MENTAL HEALTH AND SAFETY; AND
- 4 (V) THE FEASIBILITY OF TEMPORARILY RELOCATING FIREARM
- 5 RANGE TRAINING BY THE DEPARTMENT TO GREENBURY POINT AT THE UNITED
- 6 STATES NAVAL ACADEMY IN ANNAPOLIS.
- 7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
- 8 1, 2023. It shall remain effective for a period of 7 years and, at the end of June 30, 2030,
- 9 this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and
- 10 of no further force and effect.
