- 21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 22 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 23 Article Transportation
- 24 23–202.

- 1 (a) (1) Subject to subsection (d) of this section, the Administration and the 2 Secretary shall establish an emissions control program in the State in accordance with the 3 federal Clean Air Act.
- 4 (b) (1) Subject to paragraph (3) of this subsection, the emissions control program shall provide for a biennial exhaust emissions test and emissions equipment and misfueling inspection for all vehicles of the 1977 model year and each model year thereafter.

- 8 (D) (1) A MOTOR VEHICLE OWNED BY AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS A RESIDENT 9 OF WASHINGTON COUNTY IS EXEMPT FROM THE MANDATORY INSPECTIONS 10 REQUIRED BY THIS SUBTITLE IF:
- 11 (I) ALL OF THE OWNERS OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE ARE 12 RESIDENTS OF WASHINGTON COUNTY; AND
- 13 (II) THE EXEMPTION IS NOT OTHERWISE PROHIBITED BY 14 FEDERAL LAW.
- 15 (2) IN ORDER TO QUALIFY FOR AN EXEMPTION UNDER PARAGRAPH 16 (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION:
- 17 (I) ALL OF THE OWNERS OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE SHALL
 18 CERTIFY THAT ALL OF THE OWNERS OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE ARE RESIDENTS OF
 19 WASHINGTON COUNTY; AND
- 20 (II) THE MOTOR VEHICLE MUST BE REGISTERED AT AN 21 ADDRESS IN WASHINGTON COUNTY.
- 22 (3) THE CERTIFICATION REQUIRED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS 3 SUBSECTION SHALL BE MADE ON A FORM PROVIDED BY THE ADMINISTRATION.
- [(d)] (E) The Administrator may adopt regulations as necessary to administer or enforce the provisions of this section.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2023.
