12 (7) ONE VOTING MEMBER FOR EVERY 45,000 RESIDENTS OF ST. 13 MARY'S COUNTY, AS DETERMINED BY THE MOST RECENT DECENNIAL CENSUS, WHO 14 IS A RESIDENT OF ST. MARY'S COUNTY AND APPOINTED BY THE COUNTY 15 COMMISSIONERS OF ST. MARY'S COUNTY;

[(5)] (8) one nonvoting member from each county, appointed jointly by the
 economic development commission and the planning and zoning commission of the county;
