- FOR the purpose of establishing the Crime Solvers Reward Fund as a special, nonlapsing fund in the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services to provide grants to law enforcement agencies and county reward programs to be used as rewards offered to individuals for certain assistance in solving certain crimes; requiring interest earnings of the Fund to be credited to the Fund; and generally relating to the Crime Solvers Reward Fund.
