FOR the purpose of requiring certain educational professionals employed by a count of education, the Baltimore City Board of School Commissioners, or a count library system who transfer to the Juvenile Services Education Program to be in a position comparable to their former position and compensated at a salar on the same hourly rate as their former position; requiring a locally enducational professional who transfers to the Program to receive no diminate accumulated leave and authorizing the individual to retain annual leave to a credit as a State employee for certain years of service for the purpose of established accumulated rates; authorizing an individual who transfers to the Programsfer leave balances in excess of a certain limit under certain circumstants.	y public e placed y based mployed ution in be given blishing gram to

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## 1 <u>INDIVIDUAL BEGINS EMPLOYMENT IN THE JUVENILE SERVICES EDUCATION</u> 2 **PROGRAM.**

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to apply retroactively and shall be applied to and interpreted to affect any transfers by locally employed educational professionals, as defined in § 9–609 of the Human Services Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act, to the Juvenile Services Education Program on or after July 1, 2022.

8 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 9 1, 2023.
