7 8	(A) THERE IS A CLASS B-HTF (HATCHET THROWING FACILITY) BEER AND WINE LICENSE.
9 10	(B) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE THE LICENSE FOR USE BY A HATCHET THROWING FACILITY THAT:
11	(1) IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC; AND
12	(2) HAS AT LEAST SEVEN HATCHET THROWING PITS.
13 14	(C) THE LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER TO SELL OR SERVE BEER AND WINE AT RETAIL FOR ON–PREMISES CONSUMPTION.

18 19	(F) THE LICENSE HOLDER IS SUBJECT TO THE ALCOHOL AWARENESS TRAINING REQUIREMENTS UNDER § 4–505 OF THIS ARTICLE.
20 21 22	(G) THE LICENSE HOLDER SHALL PURCHASE BEER AND WINE FROM A RETAIL LICENSE HOLDER OR AN AUTHORIZED AND LICENSED WHOLESALER OR MANUFACTURER.

26 27	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2023.
