- 24 (G) THE LICENSE HOLDER SHALL PURCHASE BEER AND WINE FROM A
- 25 RETAIL LICENSE HOLDER OR AN AUTHORIZED AND LICENSED WHOLESALER OR
- 26 **MANUFACTURER**.
- 27 (H) THE LICENSE HOLDER SHALL PROVIDE PREPACKAGED SNACKS FOR
- 28 PURCHASE AT ALL TIMES WHEN BEER AND WINE ARE SOLD.
