SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
Article – State Government

2 (A) THERE IS A COMMISSION ON HATE CRIME RESPONSE AND 3 PREVENTION IN THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL.

4 (B) THE COMMISSION CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS, 5 APPOINTED BY THE ATTORNEY GENERAL:

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(1) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE ANTI–DEFAMATION LEAGUE;

7 (2) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE ASIAN AMERICAN AND PACIFIC 8 ISLANDER COMMUNITY;

9 (3) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE BALTIMORE COUNTY 10 DEPARTMENT OF DIVERSITY AND INCLUSION;

11 (4) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE BALTIMORE JEWISH COUNCIL;

12 (5) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE COALITION OPPOSED TO 13 VIOLENCE AND EXTREMISM;

14 (6) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE COUNCIL ON AMERICAN–ISLAMIC 15 RELATIONS MARYLAND OFFICE;

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(13) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND COORDINATION AND 1 $\mathbf{2}$ **ANALYSIS CENTER;** (14) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND CENTER FOR SCHOOL 3 SAFETY; 4 MARYLAND SHERIFFS' $\mathbf{5}$ (15) ONE **REPRESENTATIVE OF** THE 6 **ASSOCIATION:** (16) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND STATE'S ATTORNEYS' 7 8 **ASSOCIATION;** 9 (17) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE NATIONAL ALLIANCE ON MENTAL 10 **ILLNESS:** 11 (18) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION FOR THE 12**ADVANCEMENT OF COLORED PEOPLE;** (19) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE PRIDE CENTER OF MARYLAND; 13 14(20) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE SIKH COALITION; AND 15(21) TWO MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC. 16 **(C)** THE TERM OF AN APPOINTED MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION IS 4 (1) 17 YEARS. 18 THE TERMS OF THE APPOINTED MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS (2) REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION ON JUNE 19 1.2023. 2021(3) AT THE END OF A TERM, AN APPOINTED MEMBER CONTINUES TO 22SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES. 23(4) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND 2425**QUALIFIES.** 26**(**D**)** (1) THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, OR THE ATTORNEY GENERAL'S 27DESIGNEE, IS THE CHAIR OF THE COMMISSION. THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL SHALL PROVIDE STAFF 28(2) 29FOR THE COMMISSION.

1 (E) IN FISCAL YEAR 2025 AND IN EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, THE 2 GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE FUNDS IN THE STATE BUDGET TO IMPLEMENT THIS 3 SECTION, INCLUDING FUNDS TO:

4 (1) EMPLOY A FULL-TIME ASSISTANT ATTORNEY GENERAL TO STAFF 5 THE COMMISSION; AND

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(2) OPERATE AND MAINTAIN THE OFFICE.

7 (F) (1) A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION SHALL 8 CONSTITUTE A QUORUM FOR THE TRANSACTION OF BUSINESS.

9 (2) THE COMMISSION MAY ADOPT RULES GOVERNING THE 10 ADMINISTRATION AND PROCEEDINGS OF THE COMMISSION.

11 (G) A MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION:

12 (1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION AS A MEMBER OF THE 13 COMMISSION; BUT

14(2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE15STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

16 (H) THE COMMISSION SHALL:

17 (1) DEVELOP STRATEGIES TO PREVENT AND RESPOND TO HATE 18 CRIME ACTIVITY; AND

19(2) EVALUATE STATE LAWS AND POLICIES RELATING TO HATE20 CRIMES.

(I) (1) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1 EACH YEAR, BEGINNING IN 2024,
 THE COMMISSION SHALL REPORT TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION ON
 POLICY RECOMMENDATIONS TO ADDRESS HATE CRIMES THAT OCCUR IN SCHOOLS.

(2) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1 EACH YEAR, BEGINNING IN 2024,
THE COMMISSION SHALL REPORT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, IN ACCORDANCE
WITH § 2–1257 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, ON LEGISLATIVE
RECOMMENDATIONS TO ADDRESS HATE CRIMES IN THE STATE.

28 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the initial 29 appointed members of the Commission on Hate Crime Response and Prevention shall 30 expire as follows:

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- 1 (1) five members in 2024;
- 2 (2) five members in 2025;
- 3 (3) six members in 2026; and
- 4 (4) six members in 2027.

5 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 6 1, 2023.
