- 16 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a psychologist licensed under the
- "Maryland Psychologists Act" and qualified as an expert witness OR A LICENSED 17
- CERTIFIED SOCIAL WORKER-CLINICAL LICENSED UNDER THE "MARYLAND SOCIAL 18
- 19 WORKERS PRACTICE ACT" AND QUALIFIED AS AN EXPERT WITNESS may testify on
- 20 ultimate issues, including insanity, competency to stand trial, and matters within the scope
- 21 of that psychologist's OR LICENSED CERTIFIED SOCIAL WORKER-CLINICAL'S special
- 22knowledge, in any case in any court or in any administrative hearing.
- 23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 24 October 1, 2023.
