# A BILL ENTITLED

### 1 AN ACT concerning

# 2 Battery Storage and Solar Arrays Safety Training Grant Program and Fund

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Battery Storage and Solar Arrays Safety Training 4 Grant Program in the Maryland Energy Administration to provide grants to local  $\mathbf{5}$ governments to train local fire departments on certain safety aspects associated with 6 lithium-ion battery storage systems installed with solar arrays; requiring the 7 Administration, in consultation with certain entities, to establish certain training 8 and emergency response standards; establishing the Battery Storage and Solar 9 Arrays Safety Training Grant Fund as a special, nonlapsing fund; and generally 10 relating to lithium-ion battery storage systems and solar arrays.

1(6)(I)THE STATE TREASURER SHALL INVEST THE MONEY OF THE2FUND IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER STATE MONEY MAY BE INVESTED.

3 (II) ANY INTEREST EARNINGS OF THE FUND SHALL BE 4 CREDITED TO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE.

5 (F) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS 6 SECTION.

8 (a) There is a Maryland Strategic Energy Investment Fund.

9 (f) The Administration shall use the Fund:

12 (12) TO PROVIDE AT LEAST \$1,000,000 TO THE BATTERY STORAGE 13 AND SOLAR ARRAYS SAFETY TRAINING GRANT FUND UNDER § 9–2016 OF THIS 14 TITLE; AND

15 [(12)] (13) to pay the expenses of the Program.
